



*Session 36 — The Day of the LORD and Return of the King
[Revelation 19:11-21] — November 7, 2021*

- I. God has an **appointed** Day when the Son of Man is **revealed** from **heaven** riding the **clouds** in flaming **fire**.
- II. The LORD of **hosts** comes leading an **angel army** to earth to fight the **cosmic** powers of **darkness** and the **demonic** forces of **hell**.
- III. Our Warrior King will **tread** a **war path** from **Egypt** through the desert of **Sinai** to **Jerusalem** to finally **crush** the Beast and his hordes.
- IV. On that Day there will be a great **supper** for the **birds** of the air and the **beasts** of the earth to feast on the bodies of God's **enemies**.

- ➔ We hasten this Day by fulfilling the Great Commission as His witnesses and proclaiming the gospel to the nations!

1. How does John describe the Day of the Lord and the Return of Jesus?
2. What are the two primary signs associated with the coming of the Lord? Discuss as many instances from Scripture when these two signs accompanied God's presence?
3. How do we know that Jesus visibly and physically returns to earth when the heavens are opened?
4. Who will be accompanying Jesus when He returns? Who will Jesus and His angels be fighting on the earth?
5. What evidence do we have that Jesus will literally tread a war path through the nations to Sinai and eventually leading to Jerusalem?
6. What is the great supper of God? What context clues suggest that the battle of Gog of Magog in Ezekiel 38-39 is the same battle at the end of the age at Armageddon?
7. Why should believers desire to see this day, and how can we effectively hasten the Day of the LORD?
